Course Descriptions:

DISCIPLE FAST TRACK I BECOMING DISCIPLES THROUGH BIBLE STUDY

Provides a viable option for those busy people seeking a comprehensive engagement with the entire Biblical text. Participants meet for a total of 24 weeks, 12 weeks each the New and Old Testaments. The class also offers the opportunity to take a spiritual gifts and assessment to determine meaningful ways you can serve and live out your discipleship commitment.

DISCIPLE FAST TRACK II INTO THE WORD INTO THE WORLD

Helps to deepen our understanding of Scripture and make connections between what we already know and what we are studying. In every session, you commit to how you will respond to Scripture in terms of ministry in the world. Each week you will be guided in experiencing the gift of Sabbath rest and renewal and prayer. Classes meet for a total of 24 weeks, 12 weeks each for Genesis-Exodus and Luke-Acts. Must have completed Disciple Fast Track I. Daily preparation is manageable with 3-5 chapters of the Bible to read each day.

DISCIPLE FAST TRACK III REMEMBER WHO YOU ARE

The Study retains the familiar Disciple format with its theme word, theme verse, statement of the human condition, daily and weekly assignments and prayer. In the study manual there are 12 sessions in the Old Testament major and minor prophets (except Daniel), and on the 13 New Testament letters traditionally attached to Paul. The study examines the connection between memory and identity as the people of God. Participants will find common themes, including calls to remember, calls to repent, calls for renewal, and calls for community. Must have completed Disciple 1.

DISCIPLE IV UNDER THE TREE OF LIFE

The final study in the four-phase DISCIPLE program. The study concentrates on Old Testament Writings, the Gospel of John, the Epistles of John, James, Jude, and finally Revelation. Emphasis on the Psalms as Israel's hymnbook and prayer book leads naturally to an emphasis on worship in the study. Present through the entire study is the sense of living to completion. Must have completed Disciple 1.
